

## **Current Trauma Service Q.I Indicators**

### **Documentation:**

- Level of Trauma Activation
- Time called and arrival times of Trauma Team members by resident on Trauma Service H&P
- Attending MD signature on H&P
- Spinal immobilization status present on admit orders
- **(CT&L-spines have to be addressed)**
- Date and time C-spine cleared and by whom
- Evidence of attending involvement (i.e., on B-level activation's, note on Trauma H&P the name of attending that the case was discussed with)

### **Q.I. Indicators:**

- Appropriateness of activation level
- # of A level activation patients in the ED ,  $\leq 1$  hour
- # of patients meeting Trauma consultation criteria that don't receive a Trauma consult
- How long it took to complete the Trauma consult
- # of patients admitted to Trauma Service w/ ALOC (GCS  $< 13$ ) with head CT done  $> 2$  hours of ED admission
- # of patients with GCS  $< 8$  not receiving head CT prior to going to the OR
- # of patients with acute epidural or subdural hematoma that require EVD or craniotomy  $< 4$  hours from ED admission
- # of patients hypotensive patients with laparotomy  $< 1$  hour from ED admission
- # of stable patients with laparotomy  $< 4$  hours from ED admission
- BAIT consults on ALL + tox. screened patients
